

EXTENT OF DAMAGES

BETWEEN 24 FEBRUARY 2022 AND 24 FEBRUARY 2023

HOUSING (damaged or destroyed)

- ~18.000 multiapartment buildings
- ~135.000 single-family houses
- >300 dormitories

EDUCATION (damaged or destroyed)

at least 3.226 facilities



HEALTH (damaged or destroyed)

~1.574 facilities



WATER SUPPLY AND SANITATION (WSS) (damaged or destroyed)

- ~1.000 km of water pipelines
- ~300 km of collectors
- >236 water supply and sanitation facilities

Ukraine's territory of is potentially contaminated with explosive objects

~187.700 km²



TRANSPORT (damaged or destroyed)

- > 400 railway bridges
- > 350 road bridges
- ~ 19.000 km of roads
- ~ 14.000 km of streets and roads in settlements

HEATING (damaged or destroyed)

- ~200 km of heating networks
- ~500 boiler houses
- ~130 central heating units

In 2022, **Norway provided** support valued at around **10.7 billion kroner** to Ukraine and other countries affected by Russia's invasion of Ukraine.


